Employment Update: Revised Cal/OSHA Regulations On Hold *Posted May 21, 2021*

The proposed revisions to the COVID-19 Emergency Temporary Standards (ETS) that we sent you last week were <u>not</u> approved at yesterday's Cal/OSHA meeting. Instead, Cal/OSHA has decided to rewrite its proposed changes to the ETS in order to create new rules that will be more consistent with the state's June 15 mandate and the new CDC guidelines. The new proposed rules should be released by May 28 and the next Cal/OSHA meeting is scheduled for June 3. In the meantime, **employers must continue to follow the current version of the Cal/OSHA ETS**, but hopefully we will have clearer rules for California employers within the next few weeks.
