Employment Update: New Statewide COVID-19 Restrictions

Governor Newsom announced this afternoon that California is now requiring the following businesses and activities to close statewide:

- All brewpubs, breweries, bars and pubs, both indoor and outdoor services
- Indoor dining at restaurants
- Indoor wineries and tasting rooms
- Indoor family entertainment centers
- Indoor movie theaters
- Indoor zoos and museums
- Indoor cardrooms

Counties not already on the state watch list will be monitored for three days to determine if they will be on the watch list or be allowed to resume the above activities.

Additionally, for the 30 counties already on the state's watch list, which includes Marin, Napa, and Sonoma County, the following additional businesses are required to close all indoor operations:

- Fitness centers and gyms
- Places of worship
- Offices for non-critical sectors
- Personal care services (includes nail salons, massage services, estheticians, tattoo or piercing shops)
- Hair salons and barbershops
- Malls
