Employment Update: Bay Area Counties' Mask Orders

Napa County has not joined the other Bay Area counties in requiring masks indoors. Napa continues to recommend face covering indoors only, consistent with the CDPH. We will let you know if that changes.

All of the counties below (and also Santa Clara, San Mateo and the City of Berkeley) adopted similar orders as Sonoma County to mask indoors regardless of vaccine status. They are largely the same with only slight variations. We have included relevant county orders below so you can review as needed.
